An **"EVENT DERBY"** Consists of a Dressage test as the first phase and concludes with a jump course of 5 - 8 stadium jumps, in conjunction with 8 -14 cross country jumps. The number of jumping efforts depends on the level at which the horse and rider are competing.

DERBY COURSE SCHOOLING FEE: \$25 --- for Saturday Schooling with own Trainer

- Schooling with a Trainer is mandatory for riders under 18 years of age.
- Same rules apply regarding release forms and safety attire as on Sunday
- Schooling times: 9:00am-3:00pm

Sunday July 19 – Event Derby - \$80

- Dressage "readers" ARE allowed at all levels for this weekend
- Dressage Judge: Bernadette Radke (L)
- Stadium Phase will not be timed, only Rails Down will be scored.
- Only Cross Country phase will be timed, Beginner Novice thru Training only. Course times will be posted with the Courses. Starter division will not be timed this weekend.
- "Time allowed" will be liberal to allow for horse and rider to proceed at a relaxed pace.

DERBY COURSE: Stadium Jumps & Cross Country Jumps will be penalized separately according to USEA Rules. Time faults will be calculated at cross country rates.
Jump faults will be added to dressage scores to determine the winners. Lowest penalty score wins.

JUMP HEIGHTS:	STARTER:	2'3" max
	BEGINNER NOVICE:	2'7" max
	NOVICE:	2'11" max
	TRAINING:	3'3" max

AWARDS: Ribbons: 1st through 8th place.
(Management reserves the right to split or combine divisions if it is deemed necessary, and to alter courses and format depending on conditions present at the time of the show).

PROPER ATTIRE: To school on Saturday and compete in the Event Derby on Sunday, a rider ***MUST*** WEAR THE FOLLOWING WHILE MOUNTED DURING THE WARM-UP FOR JUMPING AND DURING THE JUMPING PHASE ITSELF: 1) BODY-PROTECTING VEST; 2) HELMET WITH CHIN HARNESS; 3) ARMBAND WITH PROPERLY FILLED OUT MEDICAL CARD. **NOT WEARING THESE ITEMS, OR USING SOMEONE ELSE'S MEDICAL CARD, IS GROUNDS FOR ELIMINATION!**

RELEASE FORMS: A Rider must have all proper forms signed and filed, including the liability release forms, with the Show Secretary before mounting. Chardon Valley Release Form & USEA Release Form must both be signed and returned.

Derby Jumping: 11AM

START TIMES: Will be e-mailed to Participants

Note: Chardon Valley Farm and USEA have separate Release Forms that have to be signed prior to riding. The USEA form is also available on their website. It will also be available at the show office.

RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the UNDERSIGNED acknowledges the inherent risks involved in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury from using, riding or being in close proximity to horses, among other risks, and further that both horse and rider can be injured in normal use or in competition and schooling:

IN CONSIDERATION for the privilege of riding and using Chardon Valley property, the Undersigned agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Chardon Valley, employees or agents. The Undersigned further agrees to release Chardon Valley, employees or agents from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, or illness to the Undersigned or any horse owned by the Undersigned or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned.

FURTHER, the Undersigned agrees to wear ASTM/SEI approved protective headgear with harness attached at all times when mounted.

WARNING

Under the Michigan Equine Activity Liability Act (1994 P.A. 351), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity. It is mutually understood that the liability release contained in this agreement shall constitute a waiver of liability for an injury to or death of an equine activity participant beyond the provisions of the Michigan Equine Activity Act, 1994.
